

Kula School PTA & SCC Principal's Report – April 2021

- I. Enrollment – 379 (K-5) plus 10 EOEL (PK) **Total: 389**
- II. Return to School – We have all K-5 students back to school every day with the exception of 58 full distance learners.
- III. Academic/Financial Plan – 2021-2022 SY Academic Plan due April 23. Staff is working to finalize and get SCC review and assurances.
- IV. Budget – Next year's projected enrollment is 424 (does not include the EOEL PK). I have held back some WSF funds in case we do not meet our projected enrollment. We will have to pay back about \$4,700 per student.
- V. Staffing – We had 2 special education teacher positions to fill in TATP 1. We secured Kristi Kakiuchi and Christina Cowell for those positions. We currently do not have any more open positions.
- VI. Hawaii State Assessment – Starting April 19 – mid May for grades 3 – 5. Grade levels will be sharing information regarding specific dates they will be testing. Students should come to school well-rested and eat a good breakfast. **Reminder:** Our school provides free meals (breakfast and lunch) for all students this year.
- VII. Rotations and specials for next school year – we are looking at having just 3 set rotations for the year (Hawaiian Studies, PE and either Art/Music/Library. We would appreciate PTA support with funding 2 of the specials teachers.
