

## Kula School PTA Principal's Report – January 2021

- I. Current Enrollment – 373
- II. Personnel
  - A. Ms. Breen out on maternity leave and Ms. Anna Geyer is long-term sub.
- III. Return to Blended Model – was postponed to February 1 due to BKM complex decision based on increased COVID activity.
  - A. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade – return to blended week of February 1
  - B. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades – return to blended week of February 8
  - C. The decision to transition between in-person, blended, and learning from home models resides with the complex area in collaboration with state. Things that must be taken into consideration include:
    1. DOH Metrics
    2. School's ability to implement mitigation practices (mask policy, distancing, cleaning/sanitizing, etc.)
    3. Considerations for elementary and secondary learning models
    4. Considerations for the vulnerable population
- IV. Academic/Financial Plan – Projected School List (PSL) – our school employees completed at end of January
  - A. Our current salaried plan is that all employees who wish to stay at Kula will remain. However, this depends on the August 2021 official enrollment count.
  - B. We plan to contact all families who left Kula for homeschooling or private school to personally invite them back for next school year.
  - C. PSL also generates the Teacher Assignment and Transfer Period (TATP) list which is posted in late February.
