### Official Rules For Pie Baking Contest:

1. Kula Harvest Festival Pie Bake Off is a nonprofessional baking competition open to the community for those 16 years or older.
2. All entries must be completely 100% homemade including crust.
3. Two entries per person only are allowed into the contest.
4. Each entry includes 2 pies of the same kind and a one time \$25 entry fee per entry. One pie is to be judged and one to be sold with proceeds going directly to Kula Elementary Harvest Festival which supports the arts and physical education programs at Kula Elementary.
5. Contestants are responsible for submitting a legibly written (preferably typed) description with their pies.
6. Both pies per entry must be submitted in pie plates (Foil, tin, glass, etc) The kind of container is optional, ***containers will not be returned.***
7. **Entries will not be accepted that require refrigeration or contain any dairy cream or custard.**
8. Entry forms and entry fee of \$25 per entry must be submitted by ***5pm on November 1<sup>st</sup>*** and turned into either Jody Kele-PCNC office or school office in Jody's Box.
9. Pie will be accepted on Saturday Morning November 23<sup>rd</sup> next to Restaurant Row at Pie Center up until 10 am when contest begins for entry. If pie is not presented on time, you will be disqualified from contest with no refunds.
10. Judging will begin at 11am and winner announcements will be at 1pm
11. Prizes and ribbons will be given after winners are announced.



Pies will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Overall Appearance

- a. Pre-slicing appearance
- b. Consistency of crust or topping
- c. After-slicing appearance
- d. Runniness or juiciness or firmness
- e. Visual appearance overall

2. Taste

- a. Flavor (strength and balance)
- b. Mouth-Feel (appropriateness)
- c. Crust (Flaky, soggy, mealy)
- d. Aftertaste

3. Overall Impression

- a. How memorable the pie is?
- b. Is it impressive?

4. Creativity

- a. How original is this pie?

Each category will be judged on a scale of 1-5 with 5 being the highest. The entry with the highest score wins the contest.
