1. Hired 3 new teachers for SY 2023-2024. 3rd grade, 2nd grade & 1st grade. & Ms. Piligrin is now a Special Education teacher.
 2. New STEM teachers which will be included in the rotations.
 3. Rotations for SY 23-24 include: PE, STEM, Garden, Computer, Dance & Hawaiian Studies. Possibly music. Maybe have the kids pick to rotate what they would like. STEM and PE will be every week even if it's not a rotation week.
 4. Art teacher: TBD based upon funding from PTA (See how Harvest Festival goes)
 5. Full time librarian will be starting soon so funding will be needed for that.
 6. ESSR Tutoring next SY- possibly for Art as well
- * It was brought up if MEO bus transportation would be available for the kids that don't have a ride home after tutoring.
7. The Strong Foundation awarded our school a \$45,000. Grant for PVC out at the Keokea Ag project. If the PTA can take in the money the funds will be available sooner and Haleakala Solar believes being a non profit that PTA could possibly take advantage of the \$9000.00 tax credit.
 8. 7 million towards a new cafeteria
